## 日惹

- 瓷器工艺村 - 瓷器工艺村坐落在班图尔省以南靠近日惹市。Kosangan是生产陶瓷的日惹和中爪哇的中心。
- 帕朗特里蒂斯海滩 - 帕朗特里蒂斯海滩位于爪哇日惹特区的南部海岸省内，在日惹是最著名的海滩之一，许多游客慕名而来。
- 默拉皮火山 - 位于印度尼西亚的爪哇岛，是一个锥形火山，是印度尼西亚活动性最强的火山。自从1548年起，已经断续喷发了68次。它是属于最年轻的一座火山，位于一个隐没带上，已被国际地球化学和火山学协会列为应当加强监督与研究的全球16座火山之一。
- 火山博物馆 - 默拉皮火山博物馆是在日惹的旅游景点之一。默拉皮火山博物馆建于2009年，它的建筑的结构非常独特。在这里，你可以看到火山模型，还有火山喷发后的状态，各种各样的景象。
- 婆罗浮屠寺 - 婆罗浮屠寺是一座位于印度尼西亚中爪哇省的一座大乘佛教佛塔遗迹，距离日惹市西北40公里，是9世纪当时世上最大型的佛教建筑物。2012年6月底，被吉尼斯世界纪录大全确认为当今世界上最大的佛寺。婆罗浮屠修筑于一座海拔265米的岩石山上；周围是干涸的湖床，婆罗浮屠的底部高出湖床15米。
- 苏丹皇宫 - 日惹苏丹的王宫是一座已有近250年历史的故宫，位于日惹市中心，建成于1756年。该故宫的独特之处是，印尼独立后政府允许原王族一家继续住在宫内，宫中所用仆人仍着古时服装。现住宫内的是哈孟古-布沃诺十世苏丹，其父哈孟古-布沃诺九世过去曾任印度尼西亚共和国副总统。
- 萨利水宫 - 萨利水宫曾一度被称为“水上城堡”，因为它拥有几个浴池和一个美丽的人工湖。由于拥有众多的香花植物，它也被称为“芬芳园”，水晶宫靠近市中心，距离日惹苏丹国宫约500米，它始建于1758年，处于日惹王宫首位国王Mangkubumi王子统治的时期。水晶宫是目前全市最热门的旅游景点之一，现在，人人都可以观赏到水晶宫的精美建筑风格——它优雅地融合了欧洲、爪哇和中国的风格，装饰着印度教和伊斯兰饰品。
- 街头市集 - 位于马里波罗大街南端的Pasar Beringharjo市场是日惹非常热闹和有趣的一个集市，在这里你可以充分了解当地人生活，一楼主要出售蜡染印花制品以及各式纪念品和稀奇古怪的小物件，二楼主要出售服饰和鞋帽等，但有趣的地方却在这个市场的后面，那里遍布着各种各样的小餐馆和旧货摊，还有各种水果蔬菜在这里贩卖。

**YOGYAKARTA**

- **Kasongan Pottery Village** - It is located in Bantul Province, nearby south Yogyakarta city. Kasongan is the center of ceramics production in Yogyakarta and Central Java.
- **Parangtritis Beach** - Parangtritis is a popular tourist beach and village area on the southern coast of Java in the Bantul Regency within the province of the Yogyakarta Special Region.
- **Merapi Volcano** - Merapi is a complex volcano in West Sumatra, Indonesia. Its name means Mountain of Fire, and it is the most active volcano in Sumatra.
- **Merapi Volcano Museum** - Museum of Mount Merapi volcano is one of the tourist attractions in Yogyakarta. Mount Merapi volcano museum was built in 2009 in Pakem, Sleman, Yogyakarta. The architecture of the museum building is very unique.
- **Borobudur Temple** - The Borobudur Temple Compounds is one of the greatest Buddhist monuments in the world, and was built in the 8th and 9th centuries AD during the reign of the Syailendra Dynasty. The monument is located in the Kedu Valley, in the southern part of Central Java, at the centre of the island of Java, Indonesia. It was built in three tiers: a pyramidal base with five concentric square terraces, the trunk of a cone with three circular platforms and, at the top, a monumental stupa.
- **Kraton Yogyakarta** - A palace of the Sultan Ngayogyakarta Haadiningrat. The palace is the main seat of the Sultan of Yogyakarta and his family. It serves as a cultural center for the Javanese people and contains a museum that displays the sultanate's artifacts.
- **Taman Sari** - Taman Sari also known as Taman Sari Water Castle is a site of a former royal garden of the Sultanate of Yogyakarta. It is located about 2 km south within the grounds of the Kraton, Yogyakarta, Indonesia. Built in mid 18th century, the Taman Sari had multiple functions, such as a resting area, a workshop, a meditation area, a defense area, and a hiding place. Since 1995 the Yogyakarta Palace Complex including Taman Sari is listed as a tentative World Heritage Site.
- **Beringharjo Market** - Beringharjo market has been center of economy activity since years ago and its existence has philosophical meaning. The market that had been renovated several times symbolizes stages of human life that is busily engaged in its economy fulfillment. It offers more merchandise, ranging from batik, traditional snacks, Javanese herbs.
