## 东京

- 皇居-是指日本天皇居住的宫殿。传统上, 日本没有定都的概念, 习惯以在位天皇的所在地为国都, 并以在位天皇居住之宫殿为皇居。现在的皇居位于东京都千代田区, 即原江户幕府历代将军所居住的江户城。
- 银座-与巴黎的香榭丽舍大街、纽约的第五大街齐名, 是世界三大繁华中心之一。银座是许多百年老铺与本土品牌的发祥地, 它是日本高级、名牌、流行、品味、信用、货真价实、憧憬、时尚的代名词。
- 新宿-新宿区域风情万种、魅力非凡。以每日乘客数高居日本第一的新宿站为中心, 车站东口是购物商圈, 西口则是办公商圈。

## 横滨

- 横滨中华街-日本横滨中华街至今已有140余年历史。具有140年历史的华人居住区, 属于日本最大的唐人街。
- 新横滨拉面博物馆-是全球首家饮食娱乐园, 建于1994。日本将拉面定位为乡土料理, 出于无需乘坐飞机便可遍尝日本全国各地名店风味这一构想, 创建了拉面博物馆。

## 河口湖

- 富士山五合目-富士山从山脚到山顶, 共划分为10个阶段, 每个阶段是一个“合目”, 由山脚下出发到半山腰称为五合目, 由五合目再往上攀登, 便是六合目、七合目, 直至山顶的十合目。每合目都设有供游人休息的地方, 巴士最高可上到2305米的“五合目”。
- 忍野八海-忍野八海是位于山梨县山中湖和河口湖之间忍野村的涌泉群。忍野八海历史悠久, 据说在1200年前就有了, 八海意为八个池塘, 是忍野地区指定的国家自然风景区, 1985年入选“日本名水百选”, 还有日本九寨沟的美誉。它源于富士山顶的积雪, 当积雪溶化成水渗入地底, 经过地底的熔岩石过滤、沉积了八十多年才终于流进忍野八海, 因此泉水相当清澈且含有大量矿物质。

## 日光

- 日光东照宫-日光东照宫是供奉日本最后一代幕府——江户幕府的开府将军德川家康的神社, 建造于1617年。日本全国有许多东照宫, 位于日光的是本社, 正式名称不带有地名, 只是为了与其他东照宫区别而一般称为“日光东照宫”, 与久能山东照宫和仙波东照宫并称“日本三大东照宫”, 最为豪华绚烂。
- 二荒山神社-被日本国家指定为重要文化财产。又于1999年12月被登录为世界遗产。神桥是日本唯一在山间峡谷间使用「吊桥」的形式是我国唯一的古桥, 也是日本三大奇桥之一。
- 中禅寺湖-在日光国家公园的范围内有一树林茂盛风景优美的湖泊, 位处奥日光的神圣火山, 它就是“中禅寺湖”了, 此湖是由火山溶岩形成的, 已有两万多年历史。
- 华严瀑布-华严瀑布, 位于中禅寺湖东侧, 为日本三大名瀑之一。源于附近的中禅寺湖底的高水压, 水流从97米的断崖飞流直下, 甚为壮观。游客可花费530日元乘电梯前往瀑布下方的石台, 以低姿态观赏。

## Tokyo

- **Imperial Palace** – Is the primary residence of the Emperor of Japan. It is a large park-like area located in the Chiyoda ward of Tokyo and contains buildings including the main palace, the private residences of the Imperial Family, an archive, museums and administrative offices.
- **Ginza** – Is Tokyo's most famous up market shopping, featuring numerous department stores, boutiques, art galleries, restaurants and cafes. Also one of the most expensive, upscale areas in Tokyo which is jewelled with upscale retail like as Louis Vuitton, Chanel, Hermes, De Beers, Tiffany and Apple.
- **Shinjuku** – One of the 23 city wards of Tokyo, but the name commonly refers to just the large entertainment, business and shopping area around Shinjuku Station. Shinjuku Station is the world's busiest railway station, handling more than two million passengers every day.

## Yokohama

- **Yokohama Chinatown** – Yokohama Chinatown is known as the world's best Chinese food spot. With more than 600 shops, there are plenty of restaurants to choose from.
- **Shin-Yokohama Raumen Museum** – It was founded on March 6th, 1994 as the world's first food-themed amusement park. From the start, our concept has been to be the one-stop place to enjoy the flavors of this national dish from renowned shops across Japan without stepping on a plane.

## Lake Kawaguchi

- **Mount Fuji** – Mt. Fuji, rising above the clouds, is the symbol of Japan and has provided a spiritual basis for the Japanese since ancient times. This 3776 meters high, dormant volcano is world renowned for its symmetry and serenity.
- **Oshino Hakkai** – Oshino Hakkai is a touristy set of eight ponds in Oshino, a small village in the Fuji Five Lake region. The eight ponds are fed by snow melt from the slopes of nearby Mount Fuji that filters down the mountain through porous layers of lava for over 80 years, resulting in very clear spring water that is revered by the locals.

## Nikko

- **Nikko Toshogu** – A Shinto shrine located in Nikko, Tochigi Prefecture. It is part of the "Shrines and Temples of Nikko", a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- **Futarasan Jinja** – This old shrine is a centre of worship located in the Nikko Mountains. Many visitors come to pray for good luck and success in love. The bridge is a popular photo spot and according to legend was constructed from snakes by local deities.
- **Lake Chuzenji** – A scenic lake in Nikko National Park in the city of Nikko. It was created 20,000 years ago when Mount Nantai erupted and blocked the river.
- **Kegon Water Falls** – Known as one of Japan's top three most beautiful waterfalls, and it is obvious why. At 97 metres tall, Kegon falls is a continuous torrent of water pouring off the side of a cliff.
