## 东京

- 浅草寺 - 浅草寺又名「金龙山浅草寺」, 是东京都内在存最久的寺院, 第一次来日, 本自由行必会排入的景点之一, 门口的大红灯笼「雷门」实在是太有名了。
- 皇居 - 是指日本天皇居住的宫殿。传统上, 日本没有定都的概念, 习惯以在位天皇的所在地为国都, 并以在位天皇居住之宫殿为皇居。现在的皇居位于东京都千代田区, 即原江户幕府历代将军所居住的江户城。的风味呢。
- 银座 - 与巴黎的香榭丽舍大街、纽约的第五大街齐名, 是世界三大繁华中心之一。银座是许多百年老铺与本土品牌的发祥地, 它是日本高级、名牌、流行、品味、信用、货真价实、憧憬、时尚的代名词。
- 新宿 - 新宿区域风情万种、魅力非凡。以每日乘客数高居日本第一的新宿站为中心, 车站东口是购物商圈, 西口则是办公商圈。

## 河口湖

- 富士山五合目 - 富士山从山脚到山顶, 共划分为10个阶段, 每个阶段是一个“合目”, 由山脚下出发到半山腰称为五合目, 由五合目再往上攀登, 便是六合目、七合目, 直至山顶的十合目。每合目都设有供游人休息的地方, 巴士最高可上到2305米的“五合目”。
- 忍野八海 - 忍野八海是位于山梨县山中湖和河口湖之间忍野村的涌泉群。忍野八海历史悠长, 据说在1200年前就有了, 八海意为八个池塘, 是忍野地区指定的国家自然风景区, 1985年入选“日本名水百选”, 还有日本九寨沟的美誉。它源于富士山顶的积雪, 当积雪溶化水渗入地底, 经过地底的熔岩石过滤、沉积了八十多年才终于流进忍野八海, 因此泉水相当清澈且含有大量矿物质。

## 京都

- 伏见稻荷神社 - 伏见稻荷神社-是一位于日本京都市伏见区内的神社, 是遍及日本全国各地约四万多所的稻荷神社之总本社, 以境内所拥有的「千本鸟居」闻名。
- 京都清水寺 - 历史悠久的寺庙, 整座建筑完全不用铁钉打斑。沿途坡道两旁是日式古老建筑及商店, 摆满了各种各式的日本手工艺品、陶瓷、日本娃娃等, 不胜枚举。

## 大阪

- 心斋桥商店街 - 大阪最大的购物区, 也是日本最长的天棚式购物街, 集中了许多精品屋和专卖店还有很多饮食店, 既有日本菜, 也可以品尝到中国、韩国、亚洲、美洲和欧洲等世界各个国家、各个地区不同的风味呢。

## Tourist Attractions:



### Tokyo

- **Senso-Ji** - An ancient Buddhist temple located in Asakusa, Tokyo, Japan. It is Tokyo's oldest temple, and one of its most significant. Formerly associated with the Tendai sect of Buddhism, it became independent after World War II.
- **Imperial Palace** - Is the primary residence of the Emperor of Japan. It is a large park-like area located in the Chiyoda ward of Tokyo and contains buildings including the main palace, the private residences of the Imperial Family, an archive, museums and administrative offices.
- **Ginza** - Is Tokyo's most famous up market shopping, featuring numerous department stores, boutiques, art galleries, restaurants and cafes. Also one of the most expensive, upscale areas in Tokyo which is jewelled with upscale retail like as Louis Vuitton, Chanel, Hermes, De Beers, Tiffany and Apple.
- **Shinjuku** - One of the 23 city wards of Tokyo, but the name commonly refers to just the large entertainment, business and shopping area around Shinjuku Station. Shinjuku Station is the world's busiest railway station, handling more than two million passengers every day.

### Kawaguchi

- **Mount Fuji** - Mt. Fuji, rising above the clouds, is the symbol of Japan and has provided a spiritual basis for the Japanese since ancient times. This 3776 meters high, dormant volcano is world renowned for its symmetry and serenity.
- **Oshino Hakkai** - Oshino Hakkai is a touristy set of eight ponds in Oshino, a small village in the Fuji Five Lake region. The eight ponds are fed by snow melt from the slopes of nearby Mount Fuji that filters down the mountain through porous layers of lava for over 80 years, resulting in very clear spring water that is revered by the locals.

### Kyoto

- **Fushimi Inari** - Taisha - Is located in a Kyoto, Japan Fushimi shrine area, is the country throughout Japan about 40,000 more than the total of the Society Inari shrine to the territory owned by the "one thousand Torii" famous.
- **Kiyomizu Temple** - The temple is renowned for its construction which uses no nails to support the elaborate wooden structure of the main hall. And with a quaint old lane lined with pottery shops lead up to this famous temple.

### Osaka

- **Sinsaibashi Shopping Arcade** - A covered shopping street, liveliest and it lines with an interesting shop.
